#### CABORCA

This historic and vibrant Mexican community extends a warm welcome to visitors who come to explore and experience its culture, history, events, charm and beauty.

#### **PUNTA CHUECA/ SERI INDIAN VILLAGE**

Located on a stunning strip of beach, with a view of Isla Tiburon and Sea of Cortez, this small village is home to the Seri people, one of Mexico's smallest indigenous groups (fewer than 1000 people). The Seri are known for their handicrafts, including their highly regarded baskets and carvings from ironwood.

#### **PUERTO LIBERTAD**

A small fishing village on the Sea of Cortez, with beautiful sunsets and fresh fish.

#### **PEÑASCO**

Puerto Peñasco, also known as Rocky Point, is a Mexican fishing and resort city on the Gulf of California. It's known for its beautiful beaches and endless variety of seafood. The Bivouac will be located at the beach, in the parking area of the Playa Bonita Hotel.

#### SAN LUIS RIO COLORADO

The Arizona-Mexico border city of San Luis Rio Colorado, Sonora has been home to the Sonora Rally from day one. Although the agricultural-based town is not a direct "gem" for tourism, the surrounding dune erg is one of the most

impressive and beautiful in all of the world. The Bivouac will be located in the city's park "El Bosque" where participants will be treated to the cultural dance, music, food and drink that make Sonora special. The award ceremony and closing party will be held poolside at the Araiza Hotel.


### **RETURN TO USA - Land Border Crossing**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### Driving rules:

In built-up areas, speed is limited to 60 km/h, except when signs indicate a lower limit.

On motorways speed is limited to 110km/h and on dual-carriageways in built-up areas speed is limited to 80 km/h except where indicated by signs.

Outside built-up areas, the following limits (in km/h) apply, except when signs indicate a lower limit:
